

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

It's important for you to:

- > Provide the facts needed for an accurate, coordinated response.
Use the emergency phone.
- > Respond calmly to any questions and follow any instructions in-house officers give you.

If you discover an emergency:

- > Stop what you're doing and shut your work down safely.
- > Alert the in-house officer to the emergency.
- > Follow the instructions given to you by personnel at all times.

If you are ordered to evacuate:

- > Use the designated evacuation routes.
- > Do not run.
- > Do not turn back.

If you find someone who has been injured:

- > Make the location safe to prevent any further accidents from happening.
- > Alert plant personnel urgently.
- > Do not move the injured person.
- > Do not give water to an unconscious person.

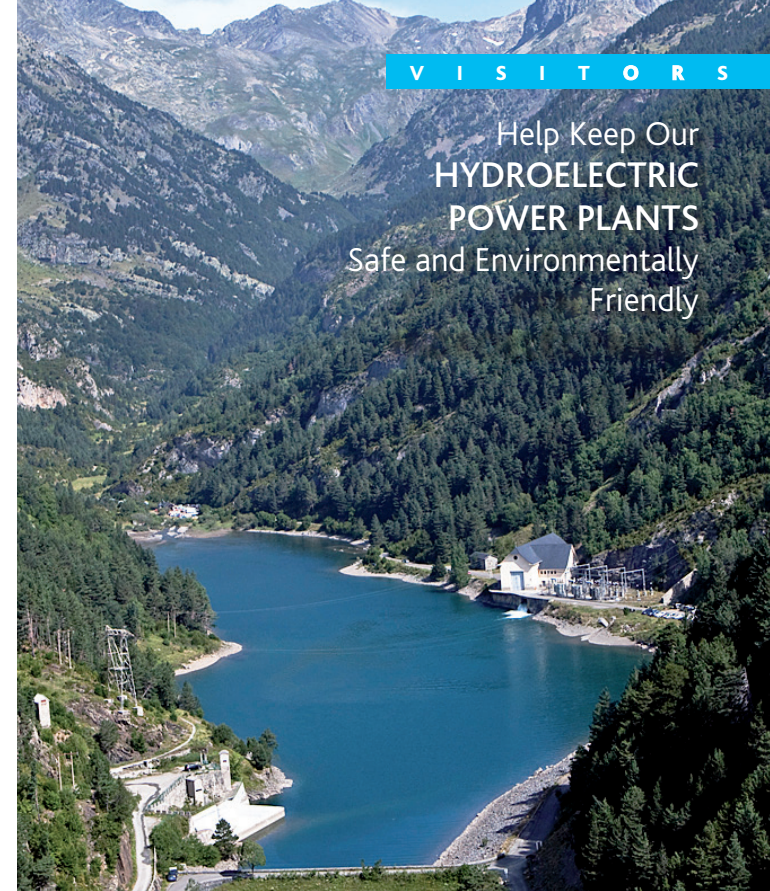

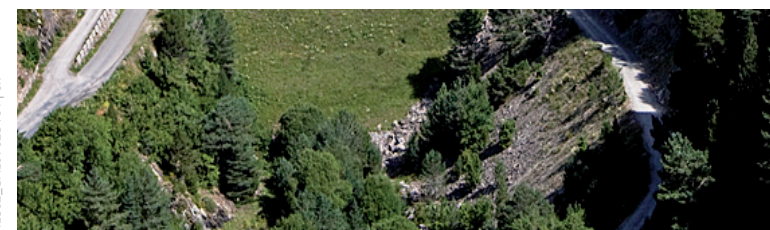

SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLINESS RULES

These are the rules you must follow while at our hydroelectric power plant.

SAFETY, OUR NUMBER-ONE CHALLENGE



Drive at a speed reasonable for the visibility and weather conditions.



In the event of an electrical storm, take shelter in the plant or in your vehicle.



Expect mountain weather conditions when you visit our facilities.



Use caution when visiting canals and dams. There is the risk that you might fall into the water.



Do not approach areas where personnel are working.



Do not approach equipment in operation.



Unauthorized personnel prohibited.



Lighting fires anywhere in the plant's vicinity is prohibited.



No photographs allowed except in expressly authorized areas.

> You may never remain at the facility by yourself without a responsible member of staff accompanying you.

HELP US BE ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY



Do not litter or dump rubble or waste at our facility, and help us by picking up any rubbish you find.



Do not store chemical products (including oil and diesel fuel) unless the storage system is fitted with a holding tank or similar device. In the event of spillage, call the Renewable Energy Control Centre (CECOER) Emergency Hotline.



Any waste produced by any activity whatsoever must be removed from the plant by whoever produced the waste (unless expressly authorized by ACCIONA Energía to do otherwise).



Do not collect water from irrigation ditches or rivers without express permission from the water authorities.



Drive only on the established roads. Driving along anything but designated paths at our power station is prohibited.



Use power and water rationally. Turn off the lights and close the taps when you have finished using them.



Do not pester any animals you come across or bother them by making noise, creating sustained vibrations or engaging in any other kind of behaviour that might disturb them.

> A hydroelectric power plant generates clean, sustainable energy. Let's be as environmentally aware as we can when around the plant and help keep the environment clean.
