

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

It's important for you to:

- > Provide the essential information for an accurate, coordinated response. Use the emergency phone.
- > Respond calmly to any questions and follow any instructions in-house officers give you.

If you discover an emergency:

- > Stop what you're doing and shut your work down safely.
- > Alert the in-house officer to the emergency.
- > Follow the instructions given to you by personnel at all times.

If you receive the order to evacuate:

- > Keep calm, do not run, move in an orderly manner and do not stop to collect your personal items. Do not turn back.
- > Walk to the closest assembly point, as shown on the enclosed map.

If you find someone who has been injured:

- > Make the place safe to prevent anyone else from having an accident there.
- > Alert plant personnel urgently.
- > Do not move the injured person.
- > Do not give water to an unconscious person.

In case of emergency, do not use the lift.

The assembly point is the location where everybody in the plant is to go in the event of evacuation.



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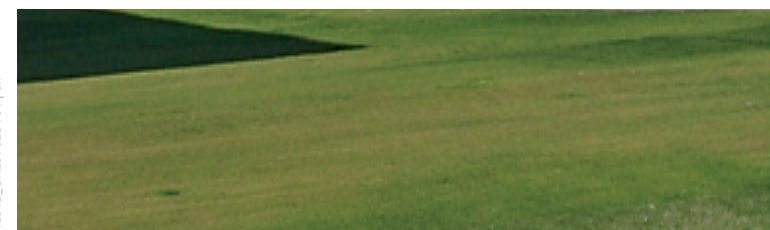

SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLINESS RULES

Here is a list of the rules you must follow while you are at our biomass plant.

SAFETY, OUR NUMBER-ONE CHALLENGE

- > Take no risks. If you see dangerous conditions or unsafe activity, correct it or report it.



- > Respect safety signs. Do not remove safety devices or danger signs.



Go straight to the control room to identify yourself.



Use the established roads to get to different areas of the plant. It is prohibited to drive or park outside the allowed area unless you have express permission from plant personnel.

Never leave vehicles or goods blocking emergency corridors and/or doors or access to firefighting equipment.



No eating or drinking outside the designated areas.



Familiarize yourself with the location of emergency exits.



No photographs allowed except in expressly authorized areas.

- > You must never remain at the facility by yourself without a responsible member of staff accompanying you.
