

WHAT TO DO IN AN EMERGENCY

It's important for you to:

- > Provide the essential information for an accurate, coordinated response. Use the emergency phone.
- > Respond calmly to any questions and follow any instructions in-house officers give you.

If you discover an emergency:

- > Stop what you're doing and shut your work down safely.
- > Alert the in-house officer to the emergency.
- > Follow the instructions given to you by personnel at all times.

If you receive the order to evacuate:

- > Use the designated evacuation routes.
- > Do not turn back.

If you find someone who has been injured:

- > Look for dangerous conditions that might cause another accident, and make them safe.
- > Alert plant personnel urgently.
- > Do not move the injured person.
- > Do not give water to an unconscious person.

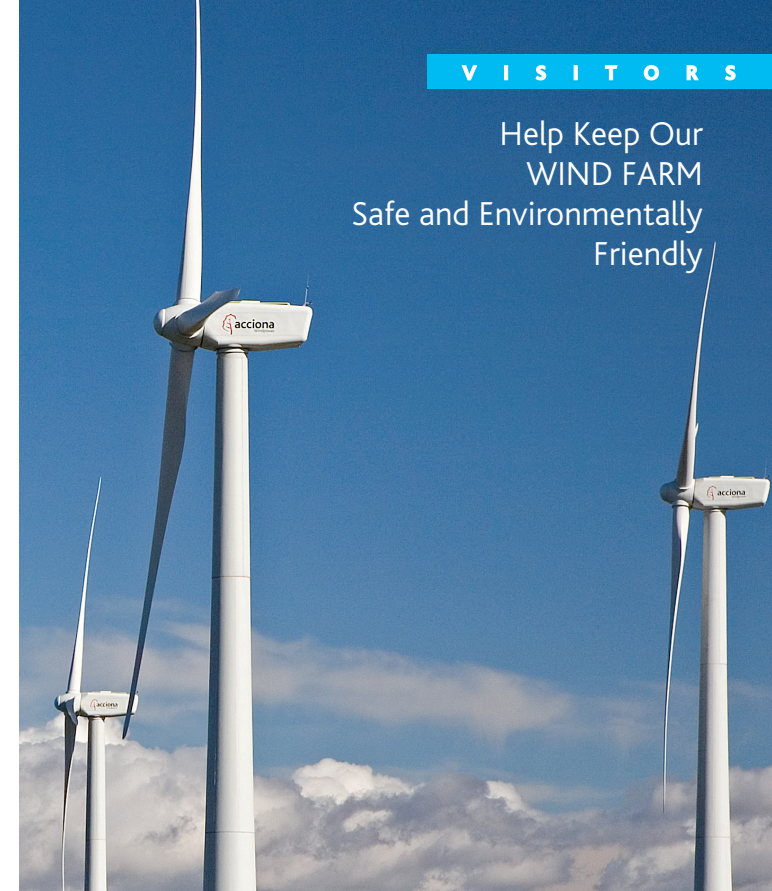

SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLINESS RULES

Here is a list of the rules you must follow while you are at our wind farm.

BASIC SAFETY RULES



Throughout the wind farm, speed is limited to 20 km/h for heavy vehicles and 40 km/h for light vehicles.

Speed limits may be more stringent in some locations, such as the Community of Valencia and Catalonia, where the speed limit is 30 km/hour regardless of the type of vehicle you are driving.



In the event of an electrical storm, take shelter in your vehicle or in the substation. If the risk becomes maximum, leave the wind farm.



Do not approach areas where personnel are working.



It is prohibited to smoke anywhere at the wind farm.



It is prohibited to light a fire anywhere at the wind farm.



No photographs allowed except in authorized areas.

- > You must never remain at the facility by yourself without a responsible member of staff accompanying you.

WIND FARM SIGNS



Only personnel authorized by ACCIONA Energía may gain access to wind turbines or manipulate control panels or switches.

Only persons specifically trained or accompanied by specialized personnel may gain access to or manipulate any part of wind turbines.



Make sure the wind turbine has been stopped before you begin your trip up inside the tower.



Snow and ice may build up on the blades and then fall off. Pay attention.

HELP US BE ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY



Do not litter or dump rubble or waste at our facility, and help us by picking up any rubbish you find.



If you find a dead or wounded bird or bat or discover any other environmental incident of any kind, report it to the person in charge of your visit



Drive only on the established tracks. It is prohibited to drive along anything but designated paths on our wind farm.



Use power and water rationally at the substations. Turn off the lights and close the taps when you have finished using them.



Do not pester any animals you come across or bother them by making noise, creating sustained vibrations or engaging in any other kind of behaviour that might disturb them.



Respect any archaeological remains you come across.

- > A wind farm generates clean, sustainable energy. We must be extra-careful to respect the environment in and around the site and to help keep the environment clean.
